Changes This Year:

- The adjacent Concourse of Union Station will host the event this year.
Why? To accommodate more brewers & guests and to create a more enjoyable atmosphere.
- The event will transition from a "competition" to a "festival". There will still be voting by the general public to determine "People's Choice", but there will no longer be a judge's panel.
Why? Several reasons, actually. They range from sheer logistics to other similar judging events popping up.

But we'll go with a simple explanation: It's in the best interest of the movement that craft beer be enjoyed & celebrated, not judged or critiqued. We hope you agree.

Brewer's Info:

- All brewers must register their beer(s) by Monday, February 13, 2012.
- A \$20 deposit per brewer is due at the time of registering to secure a table.
(Your deposit will be returned in full the day of the event in addition to a \$20 Gift Card for participating)
- Fee allows multiple entries at the discretion of the brewer.
- A minimum of 5 gallons or 2 cases must be submitted per entry for sampling.
- An original or clone recipe detailing your process & ingredients must be included.
- All submissions must be home made using grain, partial grain or extract.
- "People's Choice" awards will be given to the brewers with the most votes from the public.

The BrewerIE Will Supply:

- Tables - Ice -Glassware -Pitchers of Water for Rinsing -Dump Buckets

What You Should Bring:

- Beer for Sampling
- Another person to help you pour & staff your table
- A tub or cooler to store your product.
- Any additional information about you or your beer for the public.
- People. (The People's Choice is voted on by them! It can't hurt.)
